NOTES FOR AUTHORS OF **VISUAL** PRESENTATIONS

Presenters of Visual presentations (posters) are requested to REGISTER for the Conference (www.eubce.com). Please note that your paper will not be published in the Conference Proceedings (indexed in Scopus) without having registered for the Conference and presented the Poster in its allotted session during the Conference.

Information for Poster Presenters

A Visual Presentation is a perfect medium for communication with all interested delegates on specific topics.

Good design is essential if this important part of the Conference is to be a success, and presenters are recommended to closely follow these instructions.

- The posters must be prepared and presented in ENGLISH, the official language of the conference.
- The poster must be headed by the title and the author(s)' name(s). A good poster concentrates on the outstanding features of a project, easily grasped by the viewer, with a minimum of text (less than 50% of the total poster area) and readable at approximately 2 m (use letters at least 10 mm high).
- Advertising material is not allowed to be presented in this scientific conference. Please be aware that posters containing marketing or advertising material will be dismantled by the Organiser without giving prior notice.
- Please note that your paper will not be published in the Conference Proceedings without presenting the poster on site in its allotted session during the conference.

Poster preparation and set-up

- You have the unique opportunity to present your visual presentation for 4 days from Monday through Thursday in the Poster Area. In this way, your work and results will receive a very high visibility.
- The authors of all visual presentations are requested to bring their posters with them and to set them up on the allotted boards during registration hours on Sunday (23 June), or the latest by Monday morning (24 June) and to take them down on Thursday (27 June) after the Closing Session at 18:00.
- It is the authors' responsibility to have the poster printed ahead of time. A printing service is not available at the venue.
- Your visual presentation has a unique official session code as indicated in the Programme.
 This number will also appear on the panel which has been reserved for your poster presentation.
- The maximum display area of your panel is: **0.85m wide and 1.20m high** for posters of up to **A0 format** (841 mm x 1189 mm, upright format). The boards will be arranged in topic groups and numbered according to the Conference Programme. Double-side adhesive tape will be available to attach your poster on the poster panels. We kindly ask you to use them and **not any other kind of adhesive tapes as they might cause damage to the walls**.

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- The minimum resolution of the graphs should be 300 dpi and use simple color (standard + RGB).
- Charts generated by excel shall be inserted as a picture (.jpg, .png, or .gif format). Please use simple contrasting colors (Standard + RGB) instead of fill patterns in your charts.
- An envelope will be available on each poster panel to provide space for communication with other participants (exchange of business cards).

Presentation

During the sessions, each poster will have a dedicated time slot (about 3 minutes) in which the author can present an organised and concise summary of the work, emphasizing the objectives, approach, key results, and impact of findings. This will give all conference delegates the opportunity for questions and discussion, thus fostering information exchange, which is the major objective of this event. The authors will interact personally with the attendees, network with interested parties and discuss research results in details.

Visual sessions will be moderated and guided by chairpersons.

Audio, video-recordings and photos may be produced within this event and during your presentation. With your participation you agree that such recordings/photos may be made available to the public.

Poster Awards

In recognition of the effort which you and your co-authors have devoted to the technical work reported in your visual presentation and to the preparation of the poster itself, the most outstanding visual presentations will be awarded. The awards will be based on the quality of the technical work reported and of the presentation of that work.

The ceremony of the annual awards for the most outstanding visual Presentations will take place during the Closing Session on **Thursday, 27 June**. The awards aim at encouraging and givong additional recognition to high quality contributions that combine novelty and excellence in scientific content in their presentation. A total of 7 presenters will be awarded, one from each topic, aiming to increase the visibility of poster awards winners and as a recognition to the quality of their work.

The judges will use the following criteria for assessing the poster presentations

- **Content:** Do the scientific/technical results reflect an innovative approach and a comprehensive study of high quality?
- Presentation: Do the graphical and written material clearly explain the purpose, approach, results and conclusion? Does the poster exhibit good graphical composition, use of colour, legibility and structure?

The assessment by the jury will take place during the visual sessions. As well as the evaluation described above, we remind you that your poster will only be eligible for a Poster Award if:

- you perform your presentation during the scheduled session AND;
- you or one of your co-authors attend the poster awards ceremony on Thursday, 27 June.

In case of shortlisting for nomination, evaluators will approach you during the session to ask you to verify if your presence is guaranteed, and to explain further steps as appropriate.

Full paper and poster to be published in the Conference Proceedings indexed in Scopus

Kindly note that delivering your presentation in the conference does not imply publishing the poster in the conference proceedings.

If you wish your original paper or poster to be published in the Conference Proceedings, files must be submitted online through the user area at https://ssl.conference-biomass.com/ section "Paper Delivery" by 27 June 2024. Corresponding authors will be informed when the submission platform is open.
